The End, but Just the Beginning (Acts 28:16-31)

Here are three basic questions you can always ask in any bible study:

- What does this text teach us about God?
- What does this text teach us about ourselves?
- If this text is true, what should we do to obey this teaching? This answer ought to be specific, in that it can be clearly measured.

Here are some specific questions about this text:

- What does the ending of Acts teach us about the point of Paul's missionary travels to Rome?
 - What does the ending teach us about Luke's main point in writing Acts?
 - Why are these important lessons for our discipleship to Jesus?
- What does the mixed response to gospel teach us about our evangelization of others?
 - Does this comfort or disturb you?
 - Why do you think this passage is quoted so many times in the NT?
- What does Paul's imprisonment teach us about the nature of discipleship?
