- What does this text teach us about God?
- What does this text teach us about ourselves?
- If this text is true, what should we do to obey this teaching? This answer ought to be specific, in that it can be clearly measured.

Here are some specific questions about this text:

- Have you ever asked God to give you wisdom to see your trials from His point of view?
- Why is it hard for followers of Jesus to see their trials as God's method of making them more like Jesus?
- How do you typically handle difficulties?
- Share one of your most significant trials with your group.
- What is God asking me to change in the next 72 hours?
