

## **Discussion Questions - 12/18/22**

### The Baby Jesus Is Your King - II Samuel 7:8-17, Luke 2:1-7

Here are three basic questions you can always ask in any bible study:

- What does this text teach us about God?
- What does this text teach us about ourselves?
- If this text is true, what should we do to obey this teaching? This answer ought to be specific, in that it can be clearly measured.

Here are some specific questions about this text:

- How do you view the baby Jesus? Is it easy or hard for you to view Him as your King?
- Typically, the average American views authority somewhat negatively.
  - How does the fact that our King Jesus poured his life out for us help us see His authority as non-tyrannical?
- What area(s) of your life need to be submitted to your King?
- How does our crucified King change our motivation to serve our King?
- Who do you need to share the beauty and glory of our King Jesus with in your life — Classmates, neighbors, friends, co-workers?
