

## **Discussion Questions - 3/5/23**

### Seek God, Seek Good, Seek Repentance - Amos 5-6

Here are three basic questions you can always ask in any bible study:

- What does this text teach us about God?
- What does this text teach us about ourselves?
- If this text is true, what should we do to obey this teaching? This answer ought to be specific, in that it can be clearly measured.

Here are some specific questions about this text:

- What makes it difficult for you to Seek God? What distracts you from orienting your life completely around God, Jesus?
- How does affluence keep us from depending on God plus nothing?
- What makes it difficult for you to Seek Good? Why do you get complacent about justice and caring for those with needs?
- Why should seeking God propel us to Seek Good?
- Why do we avoid calling our sin idolatry?
- What are your 'idols'? (The things, the people, the pursuits that give you joy, contentment and hope other than God plus nothing)
