

Discussion Questions - 6/11/23

A Cure for Spiritual Blindness - Mark 8:27-9:1

Here are three basic questions you can always ask in any bible study:

- What does this text teach us about God?
- What does this text teach us about ourselves?
- If this text is true, what should we do to obey this teaching? This answer ought to be specific, in that it can be clearly measured.

Here are some specific questions about this text:

1. How do you react to the contention that we are all spiritually blind?
2. How does Jesus help us to deal with our spiritual blindness?
3. Why is the death of Jesus so important to curing our spiritual blindness?
4. How can you fight the temptation to distort who Jesus is? We often make Jesus our teacher only, or our life-coach, or the one who will make our life work better. He is our Savior. How does that help us to see clearly?
5. Why are we so addicted to the notion that we are self-sufficient?
6. How do you react to the idea that the suffering of Jesus means that if we are to follow Jesus we must suffer as well?
