A Life of Devotion - Mark 14:53-72

Here are three basic questions you can always ask in any bible study:

- What does this text teach us about God?
- What does this text teach us about ourselves?
- If this text is true, what should we do to obey this teaching? This answer ought to be specific, in that it can be clearly measured.

Here are some specific questions about this text:

1. Based on this chapter, what do we discover that Judas and Peter are devoted to over Jesus?
 - a. What factors lead to their giving into temptation?
2. How does the trial of Jesus contrast with the testing of Peter?
 - a. What does this reveal about human nature? About Christ's character?
3. Have you experienced any form of mistreatment for following Jesus in your life?
 - a. How did you respond?
 - b. What did God teach you at that time?
4. What would it mean to stand for Jesus in your context now?
How have you been tempted to compromise?
 - a. Take time to pray for boldness in your context.
