Pursuing God Through Grace - Romans 12:1-2

Here are three basic questions you can always ask in any bible study:

- What does this text teach us about God?
- What does this text teach us about ourselves?
- If this text is true, what should we do to obey this teaching? This answer ought to be specific, in that it can be clearly measured.

Here are some specific questions about this text:

1. Why is it hard to keep the mercies of God in view in our daily life?
2. What motivates you to follow Jesus? (Guilt, Shame, Try Harder, Mercy, Grace, etc.)
3. Because of God's mercy and grace, we are called to give our entire lives over to God. What areas of your life do you find harder to lay down on the altar for God?
4. How often do you intake God's Word in a given week? What are ways that you can more regularly intake God's Word? This is not meant to be legalistic. How can we allow God's word to transform us?
