Foundations for Building Community - Romans 12:3-15

Here are three basic questions you can always ask in any bible study:

- What does this text teach us about God?
- What does this text teach us about ourselves?
- If this text is true, what should we do to obey this teaching? This answer ought to be specific, in that it can be clearly measured.

Here are some specific questions about this text:

1. In what ways do you struggle with pride?
 - a. Do you tend to think of yourself too highly?
 - b. Do you tend to think of yourself too lowly?
2. What do you think of the statement, "Humility is not about thinking less of myself but of thinking of myself less"?
3. How hard is it to view others as indispensable to your spiritual life?
 - a. How hard is it for you to think that you might be indispensable to someone else's spiritual growth?
4. What might be your spiritual gift or gifts?
 - a. What is keeping you from exercising that gift in the body of Christ?
