

## **Discussion Questions - 9/15/24**

### God's Kingdom Will Prevail - Daniel 2: 31-45

Here are three basic questions you can always ask in any bible study:

- What does this text teach us about God?
- What does this text teach us about ourselves?
- If this text is true, what should we do to obey this teaching? This answer ought to be specific, in that it can be clearly measured.

Here are some specific questions about this text:

1. How much of your prayer life is devoted to asking God to help you in your 'secular' pursuits? (Academic, work, research, etc.) (Please note that all work done for the Lord is part of our responsibilities to manage the world under God's authority.)
2. Is God's kingdom, particularly the consummation of that kingdom, part of how you view your day?
3. What pulls you away from your allegiance to God's kingdom?
4. How does knowing the 'future' help you deal with the chaotic present?
