

Discussion Questions - 12/8/24

Peace With God - Romans 5:1-11

Here are three basic questions you can always ask in any bible study:

- What does this text teach us about God?
- What does this text teach us about ourselves?
- If this text is true, what should we do to obey this teaching? This answer ought to be specific, in that it can be clearly measured.

Here are some specific questions about this text:

1. How do you react to the idea that all of us were at one time in a hostile relationship with God? Is that easier or harder for you to believe?
2. What is the basis of getting our relationship with God back in order? Notice that we cannot manufacture this new relationship?
3. How can our understanding of being reconciled to God help us in relating to other people?
4. Is there a relationship in your life today that needs some level of reconciliation? What will you do about that?
