- If this text is true, what should we do to obey this teaching? This answer ought to be specific, in that it can be clearly measured.

Here are some specific questions about this text:

- 1. How hard is it to believe that God loves you?
- 2. Jesus died in your place. How does that help you see God's love?
- 3. God loves us personally in that He died for us. How can you keep God's tangible love front and center in your life?
- 4. God loved us not just in words but in actions. How does that help you when you are facing difficult trials?
