1 Corinthians 15:50-58

Here are three basic questions you can always ask in any bible study:

- What does this text teach us about God?
- What does this text teach us about ourselves?
- If this text is true, what should we do to obey this teaching? This answer ought to be specific, in that it can be clearly measured.

Here are some specific questions about this text:

1. Why is Christmas and the Second Coming of Jesus linked together?
2. Christmas means that God put on a human body in Jesus. How does this give dignity to the material part of the universe, including our very own bodies?
3. Knowing that our bodies and the material universe will be redeemed and exist forever, how should we then live today?
4. How should we view death as followers of Jesus Christ? It is an enemy, but it has and will be defeated.
