

Discussion Questions - 3/2/25

Don't Be Deceived: Staying True to the Jesus We Know - 1 John 2:18-27

Here are three basic questions you can always ask in any bible study:

- What does this text teach us about God?
- What does this text teach us about ourselves?
- If this text is true, what should we do to obey this teaching? This answer ought to be specific, in that it can be clearly measured.

Here are some specific questions about this text:

1. What truths from the sermon stuck out to you from this passage and why?
2. What are false views about Jesus, widespread in our culture, that are dangerous to believe? How does John's view of antichrists differ from popular lore?
3. What truths about Jesus bring you joy? What makes them worth sharing with others?
4. In what areas of your life do you struggle to remain firm in the truth of God's Word? What actions can you take to stay rooted in His truth? What role does the Holy Spirit play?
5. John says that we are to "continue in the Son and in the Father" (v. 24). What does it look like to live in constant fellowship with God, especially in a culture that is, at best, indifferent to Jesus and at worst, hostile to him?
