- If this text is true, what should we do to obey this teaching? This answer ought to be specific, in that it can be clearly measured.

Here are some specific questions about this text:

1. How passionate are you about reading God's Word? Is it a duty, chore, delight, boring?
2. What keeps you from reading God's Word more regularly?
3. What keeps you from having a passion to read and obey God's Word?
4. What is needed to learn how to delight in God's Word?
5. There's an old saying, "The Bible will keep you from sin, and sin will keep you from the Bible". What is the truth behind this saying?
