

## **Discussion Questions - 4/6/25**

### **1 John 5:1-12**

Here are three basic questions you can always ask in any bible study:

- What does this text teach us about God?
- What does this text teach us about ourselves?
- If this text is true, what should we do to obey this teaching? This answer ought to be specific, in that it can be clearly measured.

Here are some specific questions about this text:

1. How does understanding and believing that you are born of God help you live differently?
2. How does our relationship with God (loving God) help us to love other believers?
3. When you struggle with loving other believers, what does that indicate about your relationship with God?
4. What do you think of the following statements: When we love God we obey his commandments; His commandments are not burdensome.
5. Why should God's inclusion of 3 witnesses to Jesus help to strengthen your faith?
6. If eternal life and life itself are found in Christ, how should this affect our relationship with those who do not yet have the Son?
