## **Discussion Questions - 4/6/25**

1 John 5:1-12

Here are three basic questions you can always ask in any bible study:

- What does this text teach us about God?
- What does this text teach us about ourselves?
- If this text is true, what should we do to obey this teaching? This answer ought to be specific, in that it can be clearly measured.

## Here are some specific questions about this text:

- How does understanding and believing that you are born of God help you live differently?
- 2. How does our relationship with God (loving God) help us to love other believers?
- 3. When you struggle with loving other believers, what does that indicate about your relationship with God?
- 4. What do you think of the following statements: When we love God we obey his commandments; His commandments are not burdensome.
- 5. Why should God's inclusion of 3 witnesses to Jesus help to strengthen your faith?
- 6. If eternal life and life itself are found in Christ, how should this affect our relationship with those who do not yet have the Son?
