Romans 8:14-27 - How the Holy Spirit Helps Us to Pray

Here are three basic questions you can always ask in any bible study:

- What does this text teach us about God?
- What does this text teach us about ourselves?
- If this text is true, what should we do to obey this teaching? This answer ought to be specific, in that it can be clearly measured.

Here are some specific questions about this text:

- Honestly, how do you keep in mind that you are a child of God by grace?
- How often do you view yourself as being an heir of God by grace?
- Have you ever sensed internally that the Holy Spirit was reminding you that you are a child of God?
- Suffering is described as part of the Christian life. How do you internalize this understanding of the Christian life?
- How can it help your prayer life to know the Holy Spirit is interceding on your behalf?
- Do you understand that one of our weaknesses in prayer is that we ask for things not knowing all that God knows about the situation? Why or why not?
