2025 FINANCIAL UPDATE

We are grateful that Stone Hill Church's mission continues to thrive by God's grace as dedicated followers of Jesus are built up in the Princeton area, in the northeast, and around the world. This is made possible by God's Spirit, your service, and your generous giving. As of December 24, we have received \$2,310,000 in gifts and income. Thank you and praise God for His provision. Our total projected expenses for the 2025 ministry year are \$2,780,000. Our hope and goal is to receive an additional \$470,000 by the end of year so that Stone Hill's mission will be fully-funded for 2025. This is a similar financial position compared to the past several years so we are hopeful and prayerful that God can continue to provide as we seek to extend the reputation of Jesus and His gospel as His people.
