Job Description

Stone Hill Learning Center is searching for a **part-time elementary/middle school science teacher** for the balance of the 2025-26 academic year. Consider joining us as we help educate the next generation of world-changers! This position is **available immediately** and continues until the end of May. Classes are held weekly on Thursdays.

Objectives Of This Role

The science teacher shall replace our current science instructor who is resigning at the end of January. The teacher shall instruct two science classes on Thursdays; elementary earth science on Thursday mornings and middle school earth science on Thursday afternoons. Class sizes are small (less than 12 students). This position continues until the end of the academic year, May 22, 2026.

Essential Responsibilities and Duties

Course Content

- Teach students grade-appropriate course content. Both earth science classes use the same Apologia curriculum: *Exploring Creation with Earth Science*
- Use existing or create hands-on demonstrations and/or labs that reinforce course content
- Assign homework to be completed and submitted for grading
- Administer periodic quizzes and tests to assess student understanding

Time Commitment

- On-site time commitment: Thursdays from 9:15am to 3:30pm
- Each class time is 2.5 hours: one hour of instruction, 30 minute break, a second hour of instruction



- Procure materials needed for demonstrations and labs (teachers will be reimbursed for purchases made)
- Grade papers and plan lessons outside of instruction time
- Assist in watching over students during break time and lunch time

Minimum Qualifications

A Learning Center teacher must be a committed Christian, hold a college degree, and have experience teaching children and/or teens. NJ teaching certification is not required; work experience in a related field is acceptable. Experience in teaching science is essential.
