Romans 5:1-11 - Embracing the Gospel: Embracing Suffering

Here are three basic questions you can always ask in any bible study:

- What does this text teach us about God?
- What does this text teach us about ourselves?
- If this text is true, what should we do to obey this teaching? This answer ought to be specific, in that it can be clearly measured.

Here are some specific questions about this text:

- Do you struggle with believing that through Jesus Christ you are now at peace with God? Why do you struggle with believing this?
- Do you struggle to believe that through Jesus Christ you have direct access to God? Why do you struggle believing this?
- What are your typical responses to suffering?
- Why is it hard to rejoice in your sufferings?
- How can you reorient your heart to respond to sufferings well, knowing that your sufferings are producing endurance, character and hope in your life?
- How confident are you in the hope that one day you will be completely free from sin through Jesus Christ? What helps you to have more hope?
