Romans 6:15-23 - Whose Slave Are You?

Here are three basic questions you can always ask in any bible study:

- What does this text teach us about God?
- What does this text teach us about ourselves?
- If this text is true, what should we do to obey this teaching? This answer ought to be specific, in that it can be clearly measured.

Here are some specific questions about this text:

- There's only two spiritual positions you can be in: Enslaved to sin and death and Enslaved to grace and righteousness. What is your spiritual position and why?
- Do you see that sin as a believer in Jesus Christ is to act completely inconsistently with the person you are in Jesus Christ?
- Do you have a robust view of sin? Do you see sin as slavery and obedience to Christ as freedom?
- How can you orient your functional identity to being a slave of Jesus, which brings real freedom?
